



International Aerobatic Club Writer and photographer's Guidelines

Anyone wishing to contribute to either *Sport Aerobatics* Magazine or *In The Loop* may do so by submitting content within the following parameters:

Content Format:

HEADLINE: Appropriate to the Story, e.g. 'Negative gs and You'

DECK: Sometimes used to accent the headline, e.g. 'How I learned to love outside snaps'

BYLINE: Include author name, IAC # and other relevant information to the article, e.g. Master CFI Aerobatic

Use only one space after a period. Times New Roman text with 12-point font is ideal. Line spacing works best with single-spacing. Double-spacing leaves too much gap between sentences.

Refrain from using the TAB key to begin a new paragraph. Just double-space it.

For a feature story, use 1500-2500 words as a guide. Some are longer—others are shorter.

Please include as many photographs in the highest quality format possible, but refrain from embedding them in your document. Jpegs and TIF's are best, but digital scans of older materials are acceptable when used in a historical context.

Please include photo captions and credits with all photos.

Photo size should be a minimum of 3MB and 300dpi whenever possible for best printing in the magazine. Photos may be smaller for *In the Loop*. If photo file sizes will exceed 10MB, please submit via separate emails.
