

IAC Rule Changes For The Year 2006

The following changes to the IAC Official Contest Rules were approved by the Board of Directors at their November 2005 meeting and will be effective 1 January 2006.

Howard | Increases Maximum Allowable K of Glider Intermediate Unknowns | 5.5.7 The Intermediate Glider Unknown must have no less than six (6) nor more than nine (9) figures, totaling no more than 110K. | 5.5.7 The Intermediate Glider Unknown must have no less than six (6) nor more than nine (9) figures, totaling no more than 130K. | It is nearly impossible to create an Intermediate glider Unknown of more than six figures with a total K not more than 110K. Increasing the total K to 130K will allow the design of reasonable glider Unknowns with 7 or 8 figures without excessive use of plain turns. |

Howard | Modifies an inconsistent Intermediate Unknown figure | See Appendix 3, Intermediate, Figure 1.2.3 | Appendix 3, Intermediate: Adds optional full roll symbol to figure 1.2.3 | Adding the optional full roll symbol makes this figure consistent with Unknown figures 1.17.1 and 1.30.3 and presents no additional hardships on Intermediate competitors. |
