Greetings members of the IAC. Spring is finally upon us, and with it comes the start of the 2023 contest season. I, like many of you, am looking forward to getting back into the contest box and spending time amongst dear friends, many of which we only have the pleasure of seeing at IAC events.

Planning and preparations for the 2023 U.S. Nationals in Salina continues. As a reminder, the official contest dates are September 24-29. Practice dates will be September 21-23. Contest registration will be opened on the IAC contest calendar beginning May 15<sup>th</sup>. As always, registration and payment are required to reserve a practice slot on the official practice day (Sept 23<sup>rd</sup>) via the IAC website. Practice on unofficial practice days (Sept 21<sup>st</sup> & 22<sup>nd</sup>) will be coordinated onsite or via email with Gary Debaun and Jeff Granger, who do an exceptional job keeping us safe and on-schedule each year.

The Hilton Garden Inn will once again serve as the official contest hotel and host the Sunday Mixer (Sept 24<sup>th</sup>) and the awards banquet on Friday evening (Sept 29<sup>th</sup>). A separate event will be organized on Thursday evening (Sept 28<sup>th</sup>) for the presentation of the individual flight medals and the auction. This event is in the very early stages of planning, but will be an evening filled with fun, laughter, and celebration.

Discounted hotel rates have been negotiated with the Hilton Garden Inn, Hampton Inn and the Courtyard by Marriott. The discounted rate of \$109 will be available to IAC pilots through August 15<sup>th</sup> at the Hilton and August 25<sup>th</sup> at the Hampton and Marriott. I recommend making reservations early. This discounted rate is only available by phone. Please mention that you are with the IAC when making the reservation.
