1. Welcome: pilots, volunteers, non-flying volunteers
2. Prayer/Blessing
3. Why Mark Fullerton?
 - Highly decorated Advanced competitor
 - Ran contest like a Swiss watch
 - Dedicated to sport, helped everyone
 - We were his family
4. Roll call
5. Introductions, Contest Staff
6. Schedule
 - Contest working hours 0800-1800 (sunset 1741)
 - Tight schedule, be where you're supposed to be
 - Fly through lunch
7. Brief Ground Procedures
 - All airplanes ready to go on STARTING LINE
 - Ramp one way, northwest flow
 - No dead prop, taxi SLOW
 - Prop blast: pull airplane out, turn, then start
 - Radio check with Starter on CTAF after start
 - Upon return: taxi SLOW, stop abeam spot, shut down, then push
 - Sterile area
 - Guests must be escorted, no kids on bikes, scooters, etc on ramp. 500' crowd line.
8. Flying Operations
 - Describe box, bad box markers CTAF 122.975, BOX 129.55
 - Northwest/Southeast flow
 - Departure, noise sensitive area RWY 31 departure leg
 - Routing via holds
 - Safety check on base (Primary - Intermediate: two half rolls, any number. Advanced - Unlimited: two half rolls plus any of the figs in rule book)
 - "Break, break, break"
 - 1200' floor over runway. Runway closed during Advanced & Unlimited.
 - Exit over judges at 1500', relax, pull prop back, make 45 deg pattern entry
 - Runway 03-21 operations:
 - Use only if necessary. Coordinate with Starter or Asst Chief Judge.
 - No one in box during takeoff or landing

9. Chief judge briefing
 - Weather briefing
 - Official wind
 - Order of flight
 - Low lines
 - Chief judges inputs
10. Boundary judges
 - Someone to train
 - Driver
 - Radio check with chief judge
 - Exchange phone numbers
11. Emergencies
 - Incidence response plan
 - 911 calls
 - No posting of pictures, use discretion and be respectful
12. FBO
 - Keep FBO clean
 - Be patient and thank the line guys
 - Fuel two trucks self serve price
13. Registration
 - Keep clean
 - Water bottles
 - Keep noise to a minimum while Registrar and Scoring Director working.
No kids playing and running.
14. Canopies for judges. Please ensure all tents are secure. Let me know.
15. First time competitors
 - Grab a mentor
 - Ask questions
