Purpose: The purpose for collecting this information is to establish eligibility for a certificate of waiver or authorization.

Routine Uses: For small Unmanned Aircraft Systems airspace authorizations requested under 14 CFR Part 91, the information collected will be included in the System of Records Notice (SORN) <u>DOT/FAA 854</u>, <u>Small</u> <u>Unmanned Aircraft Systems (sUAS) Waivers and Authorizations</u> and will be subject to the published routine uses including:

- To the public, waiver applications and decisions, including any history of previous, pending, existing, or denied requests for waivers applicable to the sUAS at issue for purposes of the waiver, and special provisions applicable to the sUAS operation that is the subject of the request. Email addresses and telephone numbers will not be disclosed pursuant to this Routine Use. Airspace authorizations the FAA issues will also not be disclosed pursuant to this Routine Use, except to the extent that an airspace authorization is listed or summarized in the terms of a waiver;
- To law enforcement, when necessary and relevant to FAA enforcement activity; and
- Disclose information to the National Transportation Safety Board (NTSB) in connection with its investigation responsibilities.

The Department has also published 15 additional routine uses applicable to all DOT Privacy Act system of records. Exhibit A

2025 Mark Fullerton Memorial Bear Creek Bash Aerobatic Contest Lagrange/Callaway Airport (KLGC)

Detailed description of proposed operation:

Aerobatic flight will be conducted for the purpose of aerobatic competency and competition. The box is located over KLGC as depicted on aerial photo in Exhibit B. Vertical limits of the box are 328' AGL to 3500' AGL (1022' to 4194' MSL). The waivered airspace will encompass the area within 1 NM of KLGC, surface-4000' AGL. The required weather to conduct the aerobatic contest is 3 SM visibility and a ceiling of not less than 3000'. Two NOTAMs will be posted with the following verbiage:

LGC AIRSPACE AEROBATIC AIRCRAFT WI AN AREA DEFINED AS 1 NM RADIUS OF KLGC, SURFACE-4694 FT AVOIDANCE ADZ DAILY 1100-0030Z. Effective May 14, 7:00 AM EDT Expires May 18, 8:30 PM EDT

LGC RUNWAY 31 RIGHT TRAFFIC PATTERN DAILY 1100-0030Z. Effective May 14, 7:00 AM EDT Expires May 18, 8:30 PM EDT

ATL Approach will be advised a minimum of 30 minutes prior to use. A spotter on the ground will monitor CTAF/UNICOM (122.975) and have radio contact (frequency to be determined) with the pilot in waivered airspace at all times. In the event any aircraft enters the waivered airspace, the spotter will advise the pilot to stop maneuvering until waivered airspace is clear. No runway closures will be required. Contest practice will be May 14 and 15. The official contest will be May 16 and 17. May 18 will be a rain date. The Contest Director is Jerry Esquenazi, the Chief Judge is Hector Ramirez, the Safety Director and Observer is Charlie Sikes, and the Chief Technical Monitor is Christopher Rudd. The emergency response plan is to call local fire and rescue via a telephone call to 911 by Jerry Esquenazi. Access to the ACB will be managed by the Chief Judge. A pilot awaiting to enter the ACB will cleared to enter the ACB by radio communications only when the previous competitor has exited.

Mark Fullerton Memorial Bear Creek Bash Lagrange/Callaway Airport (KLGC) Aerobatic Contest Box Markers



The box is oriented on a 131° - 311° course. The box coordinates are:

East corner	N33.005° W85.069°
South corner	N32.998° W85.076°
West corner	N33.004° W85.084°

The box will be marked with white tarp panels per IAC rules.
